LICENSURE DATA

Twenty-nine students have graduated with a PhD in Clinical Psychology between the academic years of 2001-2002 and 2008-2009. Of these 29 graduates, 24 (83%) have achieved professional licensure and 5 (17%) have not. Note that not all of our graduates choose to obtain licensure, for a variety of reasons. For example, some of our graduates have chosen not to seek licensure when it is not a requirement of their job (e.g., for those who have academic faculty positions).
