LICENSURE DATA

Thirty-three students have graduated with a PhD in Clinical Psychology between the academic years of 1998-1999 and 2006-2007. We have updated licensure information on 32 of these. Of these 32 graduates, 23 (72%) have achieved professional licensure and 9 (28%) have not. Note that not all of our graduates choose to obtain licensure, for a variety of reasons. For example, some of our graduates have chosen not to take the exam when it is not a requirement of their job (e.g., for those who have academic faculty positions).
